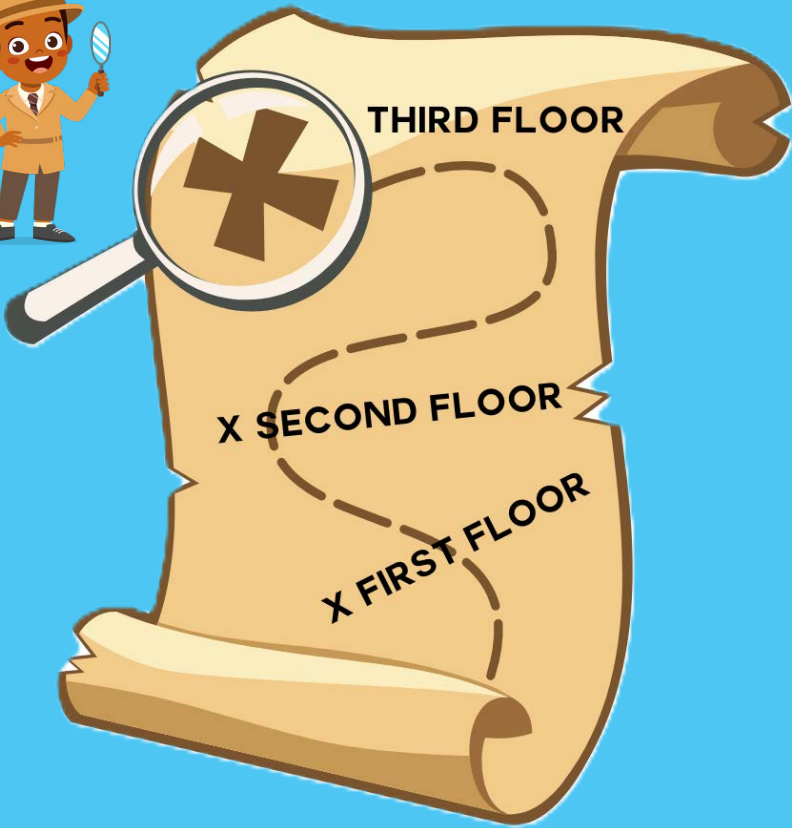

Second Floor



The House of Representatives is
the other chamber.

How many Representatives are there?



Clue: It is a number between 64 and 66.

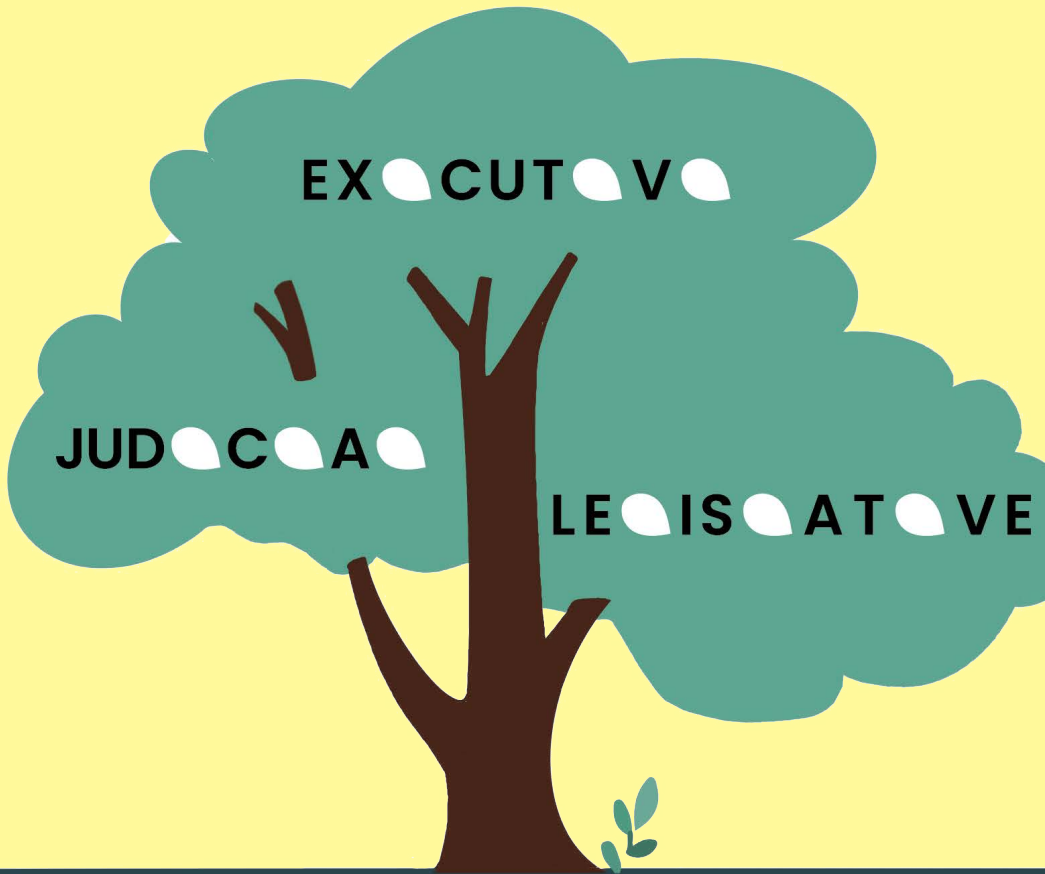

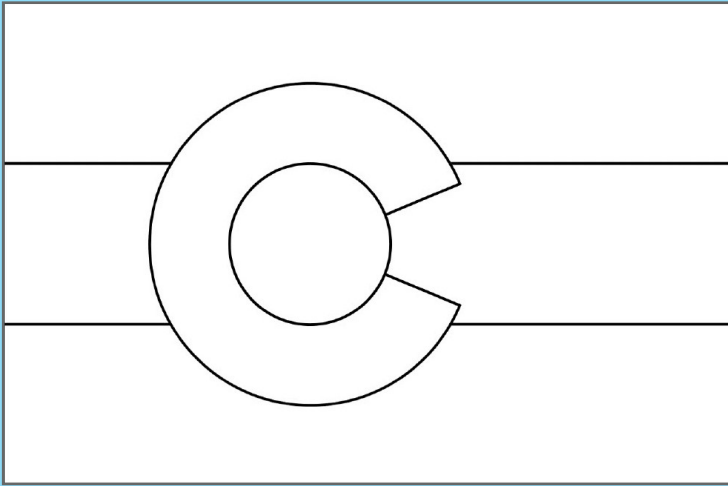

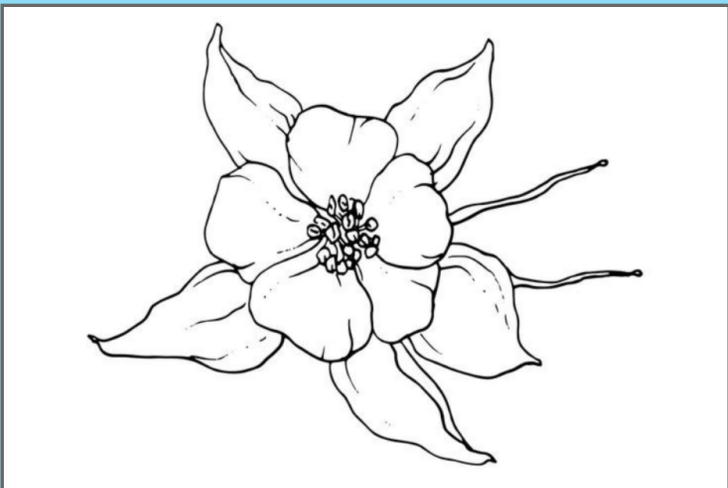
