# Transportation Legislation Review Committee

## Recommended Legislation

As a result of committee discussion and deliberation, the committee recommends the following bills for consideration in the 2026 legislative session.

### **Bill A – Electronic Vehicle Records**

Current law allows the use of electronic certificates of title in all vehicle transactions except for two instances: when either party is located outside Colorado or when the purchaser pays for a vehicle entirely with cash. The bill allows the use of an electronic certificate of title in all vehicle transactions.

### **Bill B – Clean Fleet Enterprise Replace Aging Diesel Trucks**

The bill expands the authority of Clean Fleet Enterprise to support public and private fleet operators to update their fleets. It repeals deadlines for the existing authority to provide financial support to public and private fleet operators who acquire electric vehicles or recovered methane vehicles. It also establishes new requirements for providing financial support to public and private fleet operators who replace certain aging, heavy-duty diesel trucks with newer heavy-duty trucks.
