Why This Matters

Current systems are 15–25 years old and unreliable

Compliance risk: Clery Act & Title IX requirements unmet

Blind spots in parking lots, walkways, and critical buildings

Fragmented monitoring across three separate systems

Total Project Cost: \$986,192



Phase 1 Request: \$490,826



Phase 2: \$495,366



Scope:

Replace coax with CAT6 cabling
Install modern cameras in Craig & Rangely campuses
Integrate into one unified management system
