# Department of Corrections Inspector General Offense Reporting System (IGOR)



## Tech Debt Priority

- This project is critical to the Department's ongoing technical debt remediation efforts and necessary to maintain critical data and processes.
- IGOR scored an 'F' letter grade on the OIT Assets Scoring Matrix
- System failure is a very real concern with IGOR
- Completion of this project is necessary to decommission the Department's archaic Informix data systems, which are long past expected life expectancy.



## **Current System Deficiencies**

- **Inadequate Reporting**
- **Unsupported Legacy Technology**
- **Security and Integration Risks**
- **Lack of OIT support**



## The Solution - Modern, Off-the-Shelf Investigative Suite

- Replace IGOR with a COTS (Commercial Off-the-Shelf) solution aligns with OIT's enterprise strategy and modern law enforcement standards. Benefits of the new system include:
  - Integrated report writing functionality
  - Searchable database
  - Accountability and security
  - Victims' Right Act (VRA) compliance
  - Interoperability and integration opportunities
