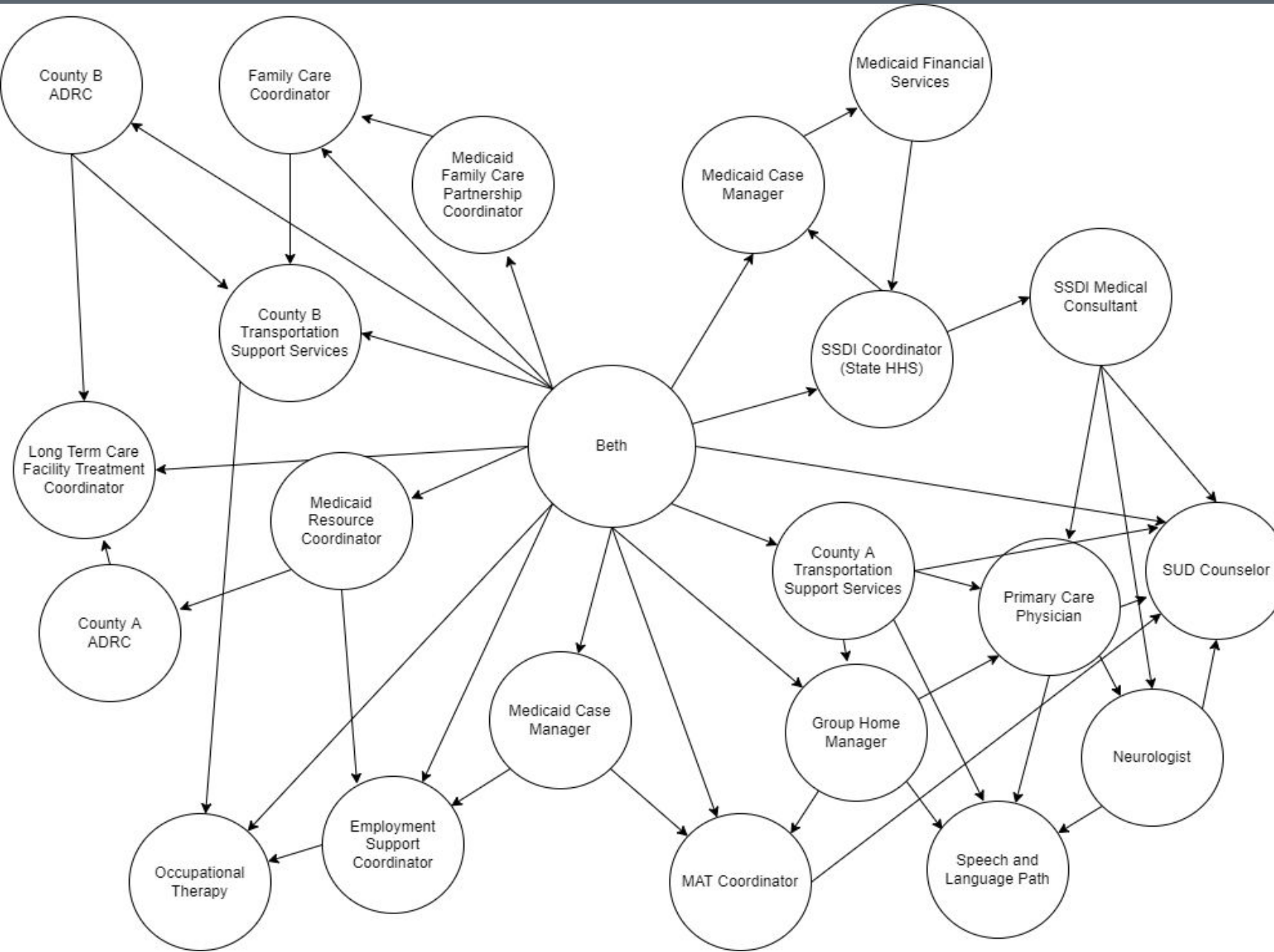

Colorado Social Health Information Exchange

- 10 year project
- Run by the Office of eHealth Innovation (OeHI) in partnership with the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF)
- Part of the Medicaid Enterprise System and owned by HCPF

Current Ecosystem



Data silos
disempower
providers and
people.

Unmet social needs impact whole person health

- Factors like affordable housing, safe transportation, and environmental impacts have twice as much of an impact on a person's well-being as clinical care

Current social care delivery is fragmented

- Data systems are siloed and providers rarely have the information they need in one system to make informed decisions about a client's holistic health

The burden of social care today lies on the person

- People have to recall traumatic experiences repeatedly, coordinate their own care, and repeat information to multiple providers
- Providers might issue duplicative referrals or unknowingly send clients on a wild goose chase

Two-Pronged Approach:

Statewide Unifying Architecture

- Build a network with a focus on interoperability and data governance, built upon existing regional successes - Contract with Resultant executed 11/14/2023

Regional Proofs of Concept

- Fund regional infrastructure and partnerships that are customizable to the priorities of the region - Contracts executed July 2025

CoSHIE Accomplishments

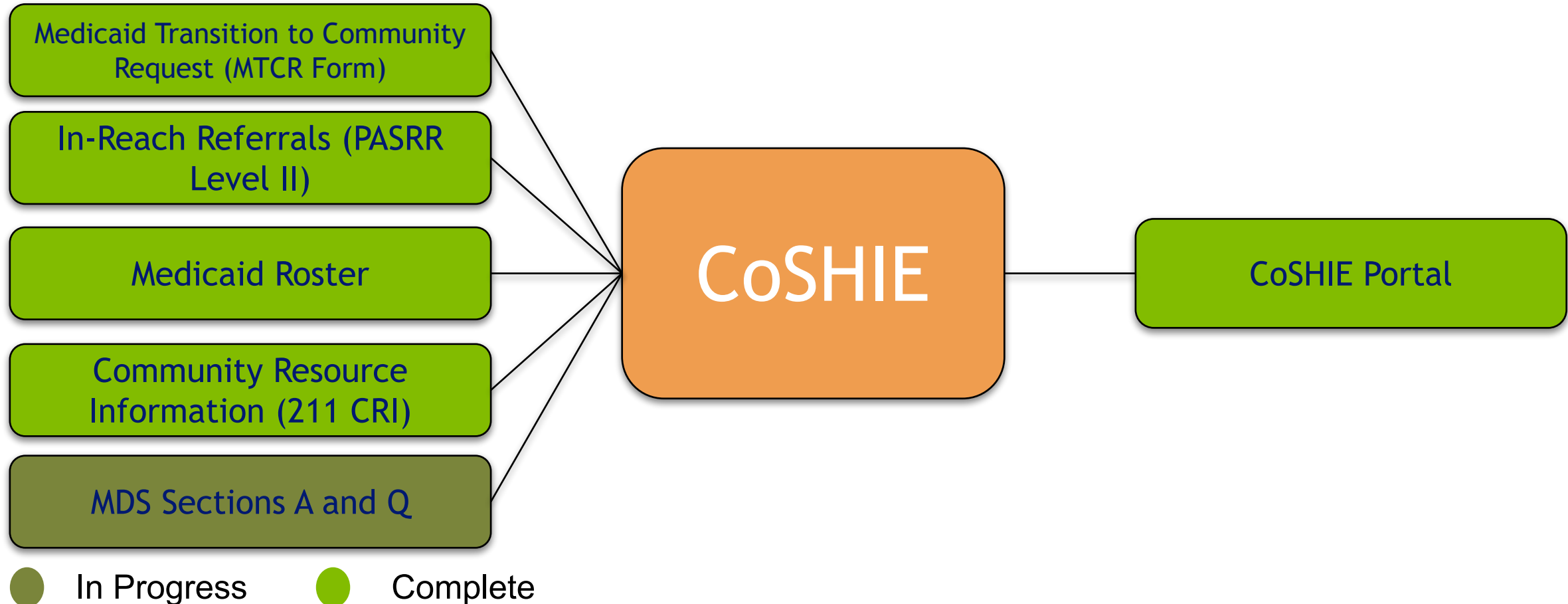
Progress

- Core architecture development
- Accelerating Home & Community Based Services transitions referrals
- Data normalization pilot between 211 community resource inventory (CRI) and an external partner
- Regional Proof of Concepts (PoCs) contracted, begun
- Receiving member's housing needs and voucher status with their care team
- Consent proof of concept underway

Up Next

- Sharing member's housing needs and voucher status with their RAE team
- Sharing member's housing needs with Denver Health care team
- Working with partners to identify and begin next SDoH domain
- Regional PoCs proving out closed loop referrals, interoperability of CoSHIE system
- SDoH assessment exchange
- Complete consent proof of concept
