

Improve the safety, security, and user experience for Western students, faculty, staff and guests by deploying a modern, integrated digital ID, access control, and video security solution.






Why and Why now?

- Safety and security on university campuses is paramount

Primary Project Components




Component 1: Digital Credential (ID)

Modern electronic alternative to physical identification methods.

More convenient, secure, privacy-protective, and usable than a physical ID.

Leverages the near ubiquitous mobile device.

Meets current and likely future expectations.

Component 2: Video Security

Deploy a modern, cloud-based, consistent, integrated, professionally planned video security system across the Western campus.

- ✓ Replace or upgrade our patchwork of cameras



Component 3: Access Control

Electronically controlled access to spaces, aka Door Access.

Alternative to traditional keys/cores

By far the largest financial investment

Can be strategically scaled to maximize affect while reducing costs.



- ✓ Maximum control & flexibility
- Near instant campus lockdown & release
- ✓ Instant deactivation of access
- Enables Digital ID technology
- Integrates with video security
