



H.R.1's (One Big Beautiful Bill Act) Impact on Denver Health

- Third Way¹, a national think tank, has said Denver Health will have **an annual impact of \$64.2 million because of H.R.1**
- Denver Health had more than **\$140 million in uncompensated care costs** last year and our **Medicaid payer mix is nearly 45 percent**
- **At least 20,000 of Denver Health's patients** will become uninsured because of this bill
- **Provisions that will harm Denver Health most include:**
 - o Cuts to state Medicaid funding;
 - o Work requirements;
 - o Changes to traditional and retroactive Medicaid eligibility;
 - o A disallowance of federal funding for undocumented patients; and
 - o Cuts to Medicaid supplemental payment programs (ie: provider (CHASE) fee and state directed payment programs).
- As a Medicaid enrollment site, we also anticipate that new enrollment changes and redeterminations **will cost us \$1 million per year** to operationalize
- Cuts to Colorado's provider fee, also known as CHASE, will have **a nearly \$100 million impact to us** over the next six years
