Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB18-1339 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 6, after line 26 insert:

2 **"SECTION 2. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal
3 year, \$6,188 is appropriated to the office of the governor for use by the
4 office of information technology. This appropriation is from the general
5 fund. To implement this act, the office of information technology may use
6 this appropriation for the purchase of criminal history record checks.

7 (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$36,630 is appropriated to
8 the department of human services. This appropriation is from the general
9 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation
10 for the purchase of criminal history record checks.

11 (3) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$7,425 is appropriated to the
12 department of labor and employment. This appropriation is from the
13 employment support fund created in section 8-77-109 (1)(b)(I), C.R.S. To
14 implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the
15 purchase of criminal history record checks.

16 (4) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$6,683 is appropriated to the
17 department of local affairs. This appropriation is from the general fund.
18 To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the
19 purchase of criminal history record checks.

20 (5) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$11,633 is appropriated to
21 the department of personnel. This appropriation is from the general fund.
22 To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the
23 purchase of criminal history record checks.

1 (6) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$41,580 is appropriated to
2 the department of revenue. This appropriation is from the general fund.
3 To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the
4 purchase of criminal history record checks.

5 (7) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$129,946 is appropriated to
6 the department of public safety for use by the biometric identification and
7 records unit. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds from state
8 agencies, including funds received from the office of the governor and
9 the departments of human services, labor and employment, local affairs,
10 personnel, and revenue under subsections (1) through (6) of this section,
11 and is based on an assumption that the bureau will require an additional
12 0.6 FTE. To implement this act, the unit may use this appropriation to
13 provide criminal history record checks for state agencies."

14 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

15 Page 1, line 103, strike "INFORMATION." and substitute "INFORMATION,
16 AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
