## AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE RADIATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** 25-11-105 as follows:

25-11-105. Radiation advisory committee. (1) The governor shall appoint a radiation advisory committee of nine members, no more than four of whom represent any one political party and three of whom represent industry, three the healing arts, and three the public and private institutions of higher education. Members of the committee serve at the discretion of the governor and are reimbursed for necessary and actual expenses incurred in attendance at meetings or for authorized business of the committee. The committee shall furnish to the department such technical advice as may be desirable or required on matters relating to the radiation control program.

## (2) Repealed.

SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
