Powers and Duties of Speaker

- To chair of House when seated as the body. House Rule 3 (b)(1)

Introduction, Reading, and Passage of Bills

Every bill is read by title when introduced and read on second and third reading on different before final passagHouse Rule 27 (b)(1)

Unless a member requests reading a bill at length on second or third reading, it is read by title on y, and the unanimous consent of the members are and the unanimous consent of the members pre sent to dispense with reading at length is presumed. House Rule 27 (b)(1)

A member requesting a bill be read at length on second or thirdreading must remain in the chamber for the duration of the reading, except for brief absences. If the requesting member is absent from the chamber for more than five minutes, the request is deemed withdrawhouse Rule 27 (b)(2

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House Order of Business

General orders. When House proceeds to general orders, no other business, unless it is a special order, is in order until general orders are disposed of, except upon a majority vote of House members. House Rule 6 (d)

Special orders. After a bill has been re turned to the House by a committee of reference for consideration by the House sitting as a Committee of the Whole, bill may be made a special order for a particular day or hour. House Rule 6 (e)

Proceeding out of order. House may, upon the affirmative vote of a majority of all mem bers present, proceed out of order to any order of business or return to an order already passed. House Rule 6 (f)
