Some of these meetings are held online; others are held concurrently at the same location. So a single person could attend both the NCSL energy and environment task force and the Summit in the same trip, and would be listed twice in this table. Travel expenses for some of these programs are funded with stipends from NCSL, using grants received by NCSL from the NCSL Foundation for State Legislatures.
